Successful applicants may have their photo (optional) and comments published in the USJF Magazine, and will receive a USJF Academic Honor Society Certificate and a patch/decal if they meet the criteria described below and provide the requested documentation and completed forms:

1. Applicant **MUST** be a current primary or secondary member of a USJF Chartered Club throughout the entire academic year.
2. Excellent attendance: no unexcused absences.
3. Provide a copy of the end-of-year report card or transcript, indicating high quality overall assessment that is **ABOVE**: standard, average, satisfactory, or is excellent or exceeds expectations.
4. Provide a Letter of Recommendation from the student's Primary Teacher: The letter should indicate the student is maintaining high quality class work and achievement while also participating in Judo classes. It is also to indicate that the student maintains respectful and courteous relations with teachers, faculty, staff, and other students. The Teacher's letter **MUST** be on school letterhead and signed. Unsigned letters, letters not on school letterhead, and/or emails will not be accepted.
5. One paragraph (approximately 30 words) from student indicating how Judo has helped him or her become a better person.
6. Provide us a recent photo (optional). It may be used in the USJF magazine or web site.
