



REGISTRATION TO GARDENA JUDO CLUB (juniors)



1. Club registration:

Registration forms...Please fill out, sign, and return by first practice day.

Registration cost...**\$25 per family**

2. U.S. Judo Federation Registration:

Fill out the registration form. This must be completed before stepping on the mat.

The fee covers you for one year, beginning with the date you send it in to UJSF until the same day next year.

USJF Registration fee is \$50.

Fill out all columns and sign at the bottom. Leave any columns open if you do not know what to write.

Please include:

- a. A copy of either a birth certificate or passport for each child.
- b. \$50 check made out to USJF.

3. Judo-GI

The approximate cost of each judo-GI with the club insignia embroidery is \$45 (depending on which GI is purchased and size).

4. Club dues

We will be collecting the first six months of dues up front for new members.

1-child family pays \$120.00 first six months

2-child family pays \$210.00 first six months

3-child family pays \$270.00 first six months

4-child family pays \$330.00 first six months

Dues will be collected bi-annually (every 6 months). After the first six months, bi-annual dues are \$120 for your first child, \$90 for you second child and \$60 for each additional child.

It looks like this:

1-child family pays \$20.00 monthly, \$120 bi-annually

2-child family pays \$35.00 monthly, \$210 bi-annually

3-child family pays \$45.00 monthly, \$270 bi-annually

4-child family pays \$55.00 monthly, \$330 bi-annually

Yellow collection envelopes with your family name will be passed out every January and June. Place your money in the envelope and return it to the treasurer by the end of the second week of that respective month. You also have the option of paying annually.

5. Deposits of obligation and commitments responsibilities of new members.

We will also be collecting \$50 payable to Gardena Judo Club per new student/family as a deposit for complying with services and obligations as a new member.

The New class in January will be responsible for mat set up and the Gardena 5K cheering contest. The New class in June will also be responsible for mat set up and the organization of our Christmas party.

Reimbursement for active and consistent participation in the commitments and obligations are detailed in the Novice Parents Obligations and Commitment form.
